

ANA to Double Weekend Flights on Narita-New York route

~ Operating Double-Daily Flights on Saturdays ~

TOKYO December 20, 2010 – ANA, Japan's leading carrier, today announces that it will increase the frequency of flights on its Narita-New York route by launching a double-daily service on Saturdays during the January to March 2011 period. Currently, ANA flies once a day between the two cities at the weekend with the new Boeing 777-300ER model configured to carry 215 passengers in three classes – First, Business and Economy.

ANA has formally filed an application to the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) of Japan for permission to begin the double-daily service on Saturdays starting in January.

The increase in frequency is in response to strong passenger demand for more weekend flights to New York. An ANA spokesman said: "The introduction of a double-daily service at the weekend will provide more options and convenience for weekend travelers and we are confident customers will take advantage of this improved service."
