

ANA Group Pilot Unions Threaten Strike on June 17

- no international flights affected -

TOKYO June 15, 2009 The unions of four ANA subsidiary airlines have threatened to take 24 hour strike action commencing 00:00 hours on June 17 (Wed), to express dissatisfaction with the management stance in their summer round of talks. The unions in question are: Air Nippon Crew's Association, composed of 457 pilots; Air Nippon Network Pilot Union, composed of 74 pilots; Air Next Crew's Association, composed of 31 pilots and Air Central Pilots' Union, composed of 52 pilots.

Air Nippon, Air Nippon Network, Air Next and Air Central will continue urgent negotiations with the unions to avert a strike. However, should it go ahead, 181 ANA* domestic flights will regrettably be subject to cancellation and/ or delay.
