

ANA announces schedule for Service Readiness Validation of Boeing 787 Dreamliner in Japan

Upgrading of 787Website

TOKYO, JUN 15, 2011 –ANA, Japan’s largest carrier, today announced the detailed flight schedule for the service ready operational validation (SROV) of the Boeing 787 Dreamliner in Japan. The validation is due to take place the week of July 4. Anticipated city pairs include trips between Haneda Airport in Tokyo and airports in Osaka (Itami and Kansai), Okayama and Hiroshima.
