| January 16, 2013 | ANA | 692 | Yamaguchi Ube | Haneda | JA804A | B787-8 | The aircraft took off from Yamaguchi Ube Airport and was climbing at around 32,000 ft over Shikoku when the instruments indicated a problem with the main battery accompanied by an unusual smell in the cockpit. The flight crew diverted to Takamatsu Airport and landed the aircraft. On Taxiway T4, they initiated an emergency evacuation. There were 137 people on board, consisting of the PIC, seven crew members and 129 passengers, four of whom suffered minor injuries during the evacuation.
