Dear Sir/Madam.

the new district **Gateway Gardens** at the Frankfurt airport is getting its **own suburban railway station (S-Bahn)**, thanks to which Gateway Gardens will be accessible from the main station in just ten minutes from 15 December.

However, extensive construction work is necessary in order to connect it to the existing railway network. We request you to consider the associated **changes in timetable during your event or shift planning** and, if necessary, inform employees as well as customers about the same.

## 1. Complete suspension of service in Frankfurt on 25 and 26 October

- From Friday 25 October, 19:30 hours to Saturday 26 October, 14:30 hours, trains
  will not run from Frankfurt airport towards Frankfurt city centre due to a software
  update of the electronic signal boxes.
- On Saturday, 26 October, from 2:30 hours to 9:30 hours, services on all lines to and from Frankfurt (M) main station will be suspended. This is also applicable for the S-Bahn (S-Train) tunnel main line.

Extensive alternate railway services have been planned and will be announced in time on electronic media.

## 2. Suspension of services for airport regional station from 26 October to 14 December

- The S-Bahn lines S8/S9 will continue to run, but will stop at the Frankfurt Airport long-distance station instead of the Frankfurt airport regional station. The S-Bahn shuttles between Frankfurt main station and airport regional station will not be available.
- There will be no **stop in Kelsterbach**. An **alternative railway bus service** will be provided between **Kelsterbach and the airport**.

- The stops of **regional trains** have also been **cancelled**.
- The **long-distance** trains will continue to run via the long-distance train station at the airport. However, there will be limitations since S-Bahn trains will also be running via the long-distance train station. The following long-distance routes will be redirected and will temporarily not stop at the airport:
  - ICE-line Cologne-Siegburg/Bonn Montabaur Limburg South Frankfurt
  - IC-/ICE-lines (Hamburg)/Dortmund Cologne Mainz Frankfurt Passau/(Vienna)
  - ICE-line Kiel/Hamburg Kassel Frankfurt Stuttgart
  - ICE-line Berlin Braunschweig Kassel Frankfurt South

The **timetable changes** for this period **are already put up on** <u>www.rmv.de</u>, <u>www.bahn.de</u> and are also available in the apps.
