Vaccination certificate must meet the following requirements.

Necessary Contents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Name (as its written on passport) •Date of birth or passport number or national identity number <p>*If only the identity number is shown on the certificate and not on the passport, an identity card matching the identity number and name on the certificate must be presented.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •The type of vaccine, date of vaccination, or date of completion of each dose
Exemption	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Children under 12 years old •Passengers between the ages of 12 and 17 years whose parents or accompanying persons have been vaccinated •Passengers transiting through Australia to a third country within 8 hours (must remain in a designated area of the airport during transit) •Foreign diplomats and their dependents •Australian Government officials and dependents •Unvaccinated passengers who meets all following conditions.

	<p>1.Passengers need to complete application of Travel Restriction Exemption(*) and are approved travel to Australia by Department of Home Affairs.</p> <p>2.Complete to registration of non-vaccination with DPD</p> <p>In the case of medical reason, passengers need to have medical certificate and complete registration with DPD.</p> <p>(*)The Certificate must meet all of the following requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The certificate must be written in English or the entire certificate must be translated - Passenger's name (must match the travel document) - Date of medical examination and name of medical institution - It must state that the vaccination is medically unacceptable - Completed the Travel Restriction Exemption application and got approved <p>•Passengers transiting through Australia to a third country within 8 hours (must remain in a designated area of the airport during transit)</p> <p>*Apply for Travel Restriction Exemption: https://immi.homeaffairs.gov.au/help-support/departmental-forms/online-forms/covid19-enquiry-form</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Passengers must have completed their application for Travel Restriction Exemption and have a travel permit from the Department of Home Affairs, Australia.
