

COVID-19 Negative certificate

COVID-19 Negative certificate must meet the following requirements.

Format	Paper/electronic/ EU Digital COVID Certificates or COVID-19 negative certificate
Language	Dutch/French/German/English
Specimen collection date	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•NAAT(Nucleic Acid Amplification Test=PCR test) Must have been inspected and obtained not more than 72 hours before arrival on Belgium•RAT (Rapid Antigen Test) Must have been inspected and obtained not more than 24 hours before arrival on Belgium
Testing method	NAAT(Nucleic Acid Amplification Test=PCR test)/RAT(Rapid Antigen Test) *Passengers traveling from "very high risk country" are only valid for NAAT (Nucleic Acid Amplification Test = PCR test)
Issued by	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•NAAT(Nucleic Acid Amplification Test=PCR test) : Tested by the official inspection agency of the traveler's country•RAT(Rapid Antigen Test) : Tested by a professional
Necessary Contents	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•Test result must be negative•Specimen collection date
Exemption	Passenger under 12 years old
