

Vaccination certificate

The vaccination certificate must meet the following requirements.

Approved vaccine	Vaccines that are approved by the European Medicines Agency (EMA) (Pfizer/Moderna/AstraZeneca/Johnson & Johnson)
Period after vaccinated	<p>Must complete the required number of inoculations within dedicated period before departure and board within 9 months after the completion of inoculations.</p> <p>*If more than 9 months have passed, the passenger must have received an additional dose of mRNA vaccine (Moderna or Pfizer) within 9 months of the completion of the above vaccination.</p> <p><Pfizer/Moderna/AstraZeneca></p> <p>-Number of vaccination : twice (within 7 days before departure)</p> <p>* For passengers aged 12 to 18 years old, mRNA vaccination within 9 months is not required.</p> <p><Johnson & Johnson></p> <p>-Number of vaccination : once (within 28 days before departure)</p> <p>•For vaccines that have not been approved by the EMA but have been approved by the World Health Organization (WHO), a booster dose of the mRNA vaccine must be given after the required number of doses.</p> <p>* For passengers who have experienced to be infected with COVID-19, 7 days must have passed since the vaccination (Every vaccination is effective with one inoculation)</p>
