(*1) Unvaccinated Passengers under the age of 18 travelling alone to Philippines who meet above requirements must hold the 'Letter of CONFIRMATION. Person who will meet them at airport has to bring the Negative RT-PCR certificate, formal request letter and waiver.

(*2) All tourists including 9A visa holders are required. A travel insurance for COVID-19 treatment costs from reputed insurers, with a minimum coverage of USD 35,000(or any equivalent currency) for the duration of their stay in the Philippines

(*3) Even if passengers have a vaccination certificate other than the designated format within the vaccination certificate requirements, passengers can enter the country if they stay designated facilities (5 days) + voluntary quarantine (9 days).
