COVID-19 Negative Certificate must meet the following requirements.

Format	Paper / electric
Language	If the document contents can be confirmed, notation other than English is also acceptable
Specimen Collection Time	within 1 day of departure (from the day before departure to the day of departure) from the first embarkation point
Testing Method	nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT:PCR / LAMP, etc.) /a viral antigen test
