

## Documentation of Recovery

Documentation of Recovery must meet the following requirements.

Format	Paper / electric
Language	If the document contents can be confirmed, notation other than English is also acceptable
Issued by	A licensed health care provider or public health official
Necessary Contents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Results of testing positive for COVID-19 within 3 months of departure (90 days)</li> <li>•Personal requirements (Personally identifiable information such as name, date of birth, etc.)               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Must match information on the passenger's passport or other travel documents</li> </ul> </li> <li>•Name and contact information of laboratory or healthcare personnel who performed the test</li> <li>•The contents shall be similar to the example below               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&lt;Description example&gt;</li> <li>- "POSITIVE"</li> <li>- "SARS-CoV-2 RNA DETECTED"</li> <li>- "SARS-CoV-2 ANTIGEN DETECTED"</li> <li>- "COVID-19 DETECTED"</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
