<p>Article 2 Definitions</p> <p>“Temporary Card” means a provisional Membership Card used for earning Miles until membership is officially approved after a Member applies to join the AMC.</p>	<p>Omit</p>
<p>Article 3 Enrollment</p> <p>2. The issuance of a Temporary Card is a provisional procedure before enrollment in the AMC, and does not mean that ANA has officially approved the AMC membership.</p>	<p>Omit</p>
<p>Article 4 Commencement of Membership</p> <p>1. Once ANA receives an application for membership and opens a Mileage Account for a Member after screening, the membership of the customer becomes effective and a membership number will be sent to the Member. If an application is declined, then the applicant will be notified of such result. If an application is declined even though a Temporary Card has been issued, then the Miles earned by that customer will be considered nonexistent retroactively.</p>	<p>Article 4 Commencement of Membership</p> <p>1. Once ANA receives an application for membership and opens a Mileage Account for a Member after screening, the membership of the customer becomes effective and a membership number will be sent to the Member.</p>
<p>Article 8 Methods for Earning Miles</p> <p>5. In the event the Miles were not automatically recorded in the Mileage Accounts even though membership has been obtained on the boarding date for the flight eligible for Miles’ accrual or as of the date of purchase of the products or use of the services offered by Participating Program Partners, Members can claim these Miles in the manner prescribed by ANA only within 6 months from the said boarding date or date of purchase or use of such products and services. However, retroactive registrations cannot be accepted or the request period may vary depending on Participating Program Partners.</p>	<p>Article 8 Methods for Earning Miles</p> <p>5. In the event the Miles were not automatically recorded in the Mileage Accounts even though membership has been obtained on the boarding date for the flight eligible for Miles’ accrual or as of the date of purchase of the products or use of the services offered by Participating Program Partners, Members can claim these Miles in the manner prescribed by ANA only within 6 months from the said boarding date or date of purchase or use of such products and services. However, this does not apply to ANA Cards and affiliated cards for which there is screening by ANA or the relevant credit card company or partner company. Furthermore, retroactive registrations cannot be accepted or the request period may vary depending on Participating Program Partners.</p>
